RULE 216

Appeals

The applicant may petition the Hearing Board in writing within 10 days after receipt of notification from the Air Pollution Control Officer of the denial of a permit or the conditions of operation imposed on the permit. The Hearing Board shall hold a public hearing within 30 days after receiving the petition. The Hearing Board may sustain or reverse the action of the Air Pollution Control Officer. The Hearing Board order may be made subject to specified conditions.
